## WEXFORD VILLAGE ANNUAL MEETING

Thursday, December 1, 2011 Highpoint Church, 7702 Old Sauk Road - Room153

- 1. Opening remarks by Don Michalski, president of the Wexford Village Homeowner's Association.
- 2. Remarks by Paul Skidmore, alderperson for District 9, which includes Wexford Village until January 1, 2012.
  - Alder for last 10 years.
  - Review of recent developments and future projects.
    - Old Sauk Road repavement and reconstruction completed. Skidmore and Mark Clear, District 19 (which includes Wexford Village as of January 1, 2012) worked to put in double yellow line.
    - Light installed at intersection of Westfield and Old Sauk.
    - Planning for jug handle intersection at Mineral Point Road and Junction Road complete.
    - New captain at West District of Madison Police Department.
    - Difficult budget process now complete.
    - Disappointed that Edgewater project will not go forward.
    - Believes that Overture Center funding has structural issues, i.e. it is a regional facility paid with local taxes.
    - UW research facility development is going forward.
- 3. Remarks by Mark Clear, District 19 alderperson.
  - On city council since 2007; former council president.
  - Lives in Parkwood neighborhood.
  - Overview of map of new District 19.
  - Review of other matters.
    - University Ave. will be reconstructed from Segoe to Allen. Conversion from rural highway to urban boulevard. More left turn lanes, medians, crosswalks, lights, etc.
    - Brush pickup ended October 15, but residents can bring brush to Badger Road facility.
- 4. Remarks by members of Saukdale Condo Association.
  - Protest Madison's imposition of special assessment for Old Sauk /Westfield light on condo residents, but not single family homeowners.
- 5. Physical status of Wexford Village (Don Michalski)
  - Village owns Lot 400, deeded as recreational area.
  - Village awarded \$2600 matching grant to fund improvements to Lot 400. (Park bench, landscaping).
  - Main Village expense is to mow the 870,000 square feet of greenway 20 times per year.
  - Path maintenance is progressing, with Bartelt filling cracks in the region west of Westfield Road.
  - The Village's 99 lightpoles have been painted and numbered. PKK Lighting has a map of the numbered poles for identifying broken light poles.
