# Wexford Village Board of Directors Meeting 

Tuesday, March 6, 2012<br>Highpoint Church - 7702 Old Sauk Road

Present: Paul Stang, Marni McEntee, Trish Watts, Don Michalski, Matt Nelson, Dick Ihlenfeld, Darrell Flemming, Jim Rather and Ken Schmidt.

1) Old Business - Maintenance Saukdale-Wexford sign and berm.
a. Members of Saukdale Homeowners Association were present to determine who should care for the berm, water the plants and flowers, and maintain the sign.
b. Saukdale will water, plant, and weed the flower beds
c. Wexford will pay for the plants, and sign maintenance
d. Motion- To finalize this agreement made and seconded and unanimously approved.
e. The issue of which association is responsible for trimming the bushes and cutting the grass - and which side each association will do - was tabled so Wexford and Saukdale members can do a physical inspection of the site together, probably sometime in late April.
2) Skip from Saukdale briefed Wexford on the issue of the city's traffic signal assessment, which Saukdale considers discriminatory because it assesses each individual household.
a. Saukdale members requested that Wexford go on record supporting Saukdale's position.
b. Motion that Condominium owners should be treated like single-family homeowners for purposes of traffic signal assessments seconded and unanimously approved.
3) Financial Report - Paul
a. Reviewed February 2012 Treasurer Report and summary of receipts and disbursements.
b. Reviewed status of dues collections. 65 homes were sent a second notice.
c. Paul noted that one homeowner's annual association fee check bounced. The bank charged the association a fee when the check didn't clear.
d. Motion: From here on forward any time the association gets charged a nonsufficient funds fee for a bounced check, that fee amount will be billed back to the homeowner; seconded and unanimously approved.
e. Motion to accept February financial report seconded and approved
4) New Business
a. Lot line for 7002 Sawmill Road - It was determined that outlots such as lot 32 are within the association boundaries.
b. Little libraries - A birdhouse-like structure where people in the neighborhood can exchange books for free
c. Motion to accept little libraries and endorse their use as long as they are on private property and maintained by that property owner.
